You told me that your top concerns are affordable housing, cost-of-living, grocery prices, climate change, and supporting small businesses - and we are taking action.

Our Canadian government is pushing forward with a real plan to continue supporting the middle class. Finally, I want to thank everyone who joined us for my sixth annual community barbeque on July 15th. My team and I welcomed more than 5,000 neighbours for an afternoon of good food, live performances, and connecting with our community. It was a fantastic time and I can't wait to see you at my next one in 2024!

Thank you for placing your trust in me to champion our community in the Government of Canada. I hope you will continue to reach out to me in the coming months as we work to support the middle class, build a cleaner economy, and make life more affordable in Mississauga-Erin Mills.
