In our riding, we are focused on addressing the needs that matter most to you, whether that's ensuring access to affordable dental care, expanding food security through the National School Food Program, or supporting local housing initiatives through the Housing Accelerator Fund. FEDERAL BENEFITS AND CREDITS—MONTHLY

Canada Child Benefit (CCB)

A monthly, tax-free benefit for eligible families with kids under 17, with a supplement for kids under 6 and kids with disabilities. Payments are indexed to inflation and increase annually in July.

You can apply to start receiving this payment when you receive your child's birth certificate.

Depending on your income, your monthly payment can be **up to \$648.91** per child under 6 and **up to \$547.50** per child ages 6-17.

Veterans Disability Pension (VDP)

A monthly, tax-free financial benefit to support the well-being of eligible Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) and Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) members or veterans. Applicants must have a diagnosed medical condition or disability that is a result of their service.

You can apply to receive this payment through your My Veterans Affairs Account, or by mail. The amount you receive is based on your Military class and the severity of your condition.

FEDERAL BENEFITS AND CREDITS—MONTHLY (SENIORS)

Canada Pension Plan (CPP)

A monthly, taxable benefit for eligible Canadian seniors that replaces a part of your income when you retire. You may choose to start receiving your CPP starting at 60 and no later than 70.

You must apply either online through your My Service Canada Account or by mail to start receiving this payment.

Most Canadians pay automatically into your Canada Pension Plan throughout your working life. The amount you receive depends on the contributions you make during your working career.

Old Age Security (OAS)

A monthly, taxable benefit for Canadians starting at age 65, which increases when you turn 75. The payment is indexed to inflation, meaning it rises each year at the same rate as the consumer price index.

Most Canadians are automatically enrolled at age 65. You must have resided in Canada for at least 10 years to qualify.

Depending on your income, you can receive **up to \$727.67** per month at age 65, increasing **up to \$800.44** per month at age 75.

Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS)

A monthly, tax-free income supplement for lower-income seniors who also already qualify to receive Old Age Security. The payment is indexed to inflation, meaning it rises each year at the same rate as the consumer price index.

Most eligible Canadians are automatically enrolled and will not need to apply.

Depending on your household retirement income, you can receive **up to \$1086.99** per month.

FEDERAL BENEFITS AND CREDITS—QUARTERLY

Advanced Canada Workers' Benefit (CWB)

A refundable tax credit to support low-income workers. Residents who live with a disability and have a valid Disability Tax Credit may also apply to receive an additional supplement. As of July 2023, you may receive up to 50% in advance through three payments during the year.

You must complete Schedule 6 when filing your taxes to receive this benefit.

The base benefit provides **up to \$1518** per individual and **up to \$2616** per family. The disability supplement provides **up to \$784** on top of the base amount.

Canada Carbon Rebate

A quarterly, tax-free payment for residents in Ontario and other provinces. The amount increases regularly to ensure that most Canadians with an average gas use receive more than what is paid in carbon pricing.

You receive this payment automatically after filing your taxes each year. It is paid per household and the amount increases each April.

For 2024, the base payments are: **\$140 per individual, \$70 for a spouse, \$70 for the first child under 19 years of age, and \$35 per additional child under 19.**

Goods and Services Tax Credit (GST Credit)

A quarterly, tax-free benefit that helps individuals and families with low to modest incomes offset the average GST they pay throughout the year. The amount is recalculated each year starting with your July payment.

You are automatically considered for the GST credit when you file your taxes each year.

Depending on your income, you may annually receive **up to \$519** as a single individual, **up to \$680** if you are married or have a common-law partner, and **up to \$179** for each child under 19 years old.
